I. Seeking God first.

A. Spend some time reading and studying Proverbs 3. (Proverbs 3:5-6. These verses are inscribed inside my parents wedding bands.) It talks about sound teaching, trusting in the Lord, and being wise.

A. False teachers are addressed again. What is said about them?

B. Verse 6 says: "Godliness with contentment is great gain." What does this mean?

C. How are we to be content?

D. I Timothy ends with some final words for believers, what are these instructions?
