8. What command does Jesus give to Peter?
9. Read John 21:25 and think about what it says. Do you have any thoughts regarding this verse?

III. Searching Resources.

1. Research what happens to the disciples after Jesus ascends. What did you learn?
2. What do commentaries say in regards to John 20:22?
