II. Studying His Word.

- F. What happened to the 5 Amorite kings?
- G. Joshua 10:29-43 tells of the conquest of Southern Canaan and Joshua 11:1-23 tells of the conquests in Northern Canaan. What do these passages tell us that the Lord does?

III. Searching Resources.

- A. Take a look at a map and see where all of these battles took place. Maybe even make a chart with some detail to help you get a better idea of the territories involved and the work of the Lord that happened.

IV. Sharing with one another.

- A. Is there a situation that comes to mind when you had to completely rely on the Lord and you were very aware that His Hand was guiding the situation?
