Additionally, our First Kids Ministry will release weekly helps in their e-letter for how to take advantage of this Bible reading plan during your family devotions and worship time with children at home.

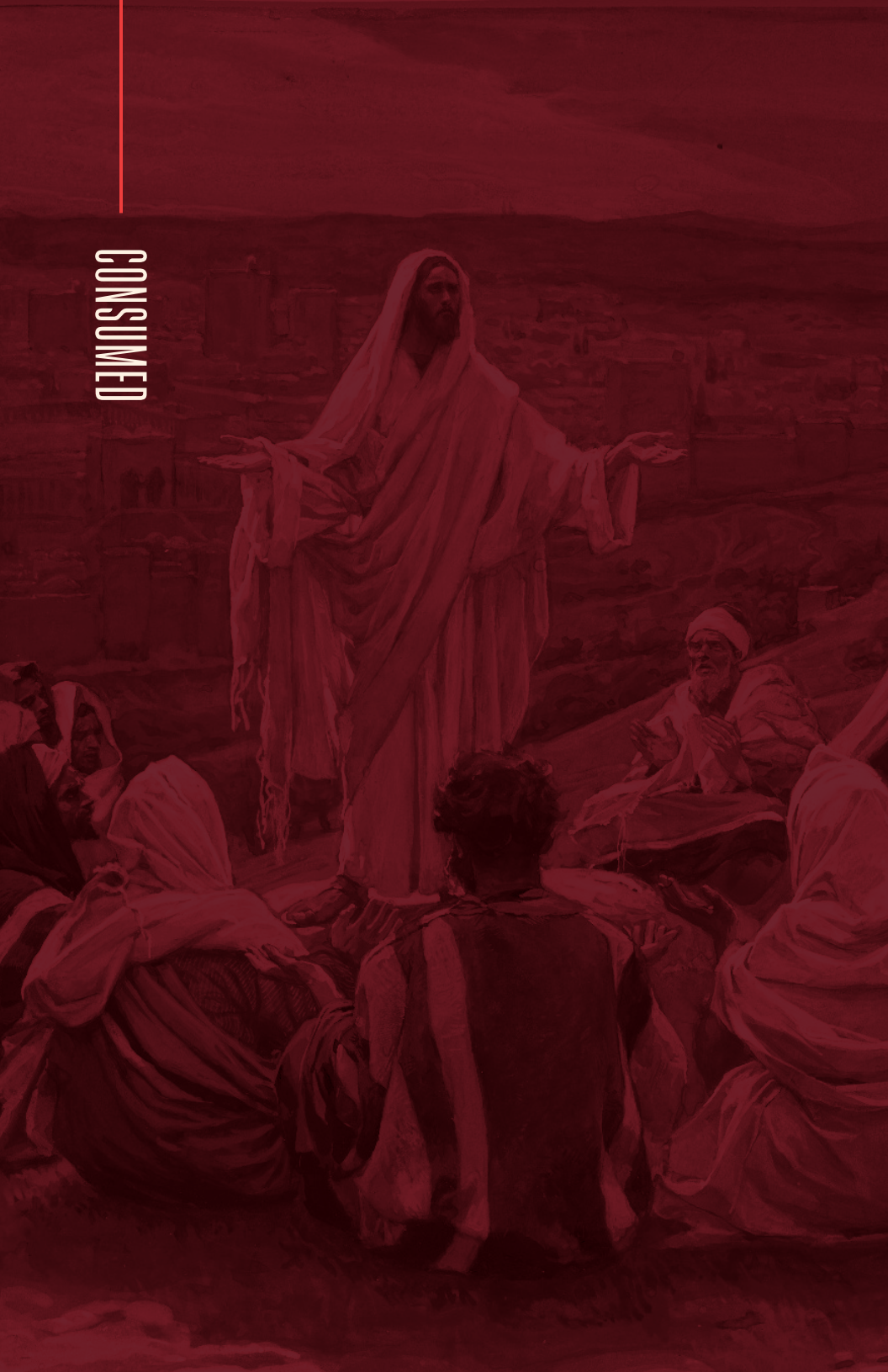

HOW CAN WE HEAR FROM GOD?

The Bible is not only able to make us smarter or more disciplined; the Bible allows us to hear from God. However, when we commit to a daily Bible reading plan it is easy to end up focused on checking boxes – and then experiencing guilt when we fall behind.

So, how can we read the Bible in a way that can actually change our lives?

One way is by adopting the H.E.A.R. method – Highlight. Explain. Respond.

God is speaking. The question is, are you listening?

- HAVE**
- Your favorite Bible or YouVersion Bible App
 - A prayer journal, notes app, word doc, (or napkin from lunch)
 - An open heart, ready to hear from God

PRAY Begin each daily reading time with prayer:
“God, as you speak to me, help me to listen.”

READ Read the passage, with your mind ready to HEAR from God.

H As you read the passage, highlight one or two verses that stand out to you by copying down the chapter and verse reference. You might jot down word for word the phrase or key portion that stands out to you.

E Explain what the highlighted verse(s) means. You don’t have to be the most technical or answer the most complicated questions about the verse. You can simply summarize the main point being communicated in the verse(s) by asking a few key questions: *why was the text written, to whom was it originally written, how does this verse fit with the rest of the passage, why did the Holy Spirit include these verses, and what does the Holy Spirit intend to communicate through this verse?* Keep your summary of what the verse(s) is saying to just a few short sentences.

A Learning to apply what you hear God saying in His Word is the key to experiencing life change through Bible reading. In order to know how you should apply the key verses you read in the passage, you might ask the following questions: *What does this text teach me about God? What does it teach me about myself and the world around me? How could one apply these words to their life? Is there an action or attitude to avoid or embrace in the text? What is God saying to me through these words?* Write a few sentences about how you can apply the text in your life.

R Respond to what you are hearing. Your response may take different forms. You might write out a prayer, or describe how your life may change because of this text. You might write the name of a person to pray for, or friend who needs the Gospel.

JAN. 4 // GEN 6-7

H - "The LORD regretted that he had made man on the earth, and he was deeply grieved." GEN 6:6

E - God's righteousness demands judgement for sin. Judgement is NOT soft + easy; it is harsh and thorough. Every living thing God had made, wiped from the face of the earth because of the grief He experienced over the sin of the world.

A - I recognize that SIN in my life is a serious matter to God. The Lord wants sin purged from my life. I must be more serious about the sin in my life, recognize the grief my sin causes God, and be more committed to deal severely with temptations I face. But, ultimately I need to thank God that His regret over my sin did not lead to my destruction, but rather to my redemption. God made a way for my deliverance - not by an ark, but through the CROSS. ✠

R - God, I want to be repulsed by my sin, as it repulses you. Help me to be more aware of the grief my sin causes you. I am thankful for the way of escape of certain destruction you provided the death, burial, & resurrection of JESUS! Help me be more faithful in sharing that Good News with others who have not heard.

Highlights Only

🕒 5 MINUTES

If you are short on time, we still want you to engage with God's word. You can just read the *Highlights* for each day in about 5 minutes.

Full Reading

🕒 15-20 MINUTES

The full readings will take you through the entire Bible in a year with 6 daily readings per week.

HEAR Journal

🕒 20-30 MINUTES

If you really want to experience life change through God's Word, use a HEAR journal to Highlight, Explain, Apply, and Respond to what you are reading each day.

What if I can't read all of the assigned reading in a given day?

On each day's reading, there is a passage in italics. If you are short on time for any given day, start by reading the passage in italics. That will give you the highlights for that day. If you have time to read more, then keep going.

What if I fall behind?

Always start with the reading for that day. Don't try and catch up first. If you want to go back to a specific passage you missed, then do that after you finish today's reading. There are only 6 assigned days of reading each week, so you can always use day 7 as a catch up day.

What if I get to a passage I don't understand?

That's okay! There are parts of the Bible that are very difficult to understand. It is normal to have questions about portions of the Bible. Tell God in prayer and ask Him for wisdom to understand. You might make a note of the difficult to understand passage or verse and seek outside help later, but in the moment, it may be best to simply focus on getting the big picture of how the Bible's story develops. Very often, the difficult to understand aspects of the story become clearer as the story of the Bible develops.

Why aren't we just reading the books in order?

The Bible's 66 books weave together an amazing, cohesive, grand story that God has written about the history and future of the world. Some sections of the Bible give different perspectives of the same story. By reading it in chronological order, we are better able to see how the overall story fits together, how it develops, where its climax comes, and how it invites us to join in a never-ending script that God continues to write.

What are some good tips for starting a Bible reading plan?

Read at a specific time and place each day and do so until it becomes a habit. Read in community with others. Since our whole church is reading through the Bible together, take time to share what you are learning, hear from others, and hold each other accountable in reading and applying God's Word.

READING GOD'S STORY

A Chronological Study of God's Word

This plan, by Dr. George Guthrie, organizes the material of the Bible to flow in **chronological order** so that the reader can grasp the overall story of Scripture from beginning to end. Where it is impossible to determine an exact date of materials or events in the Scriptures, there is a commitment to give the reader a general flow and development of the Bible's grand story. Some passages are placed in the plan according to topic (i.e., John 1:1-3 is included in the creation narrative from Genesis 1-2, many of the Psalms are dispersed throughout the plan according to event or topic, etc.).

"In the beginning..." **GENESIS 1:1 / JOHN 1:1**



There are **six readings** for each week with the intention that we will **all read Day One on Mondays and Day Six on Saturdays**. On **Day Seven**, the **Pastor will preach** from a text within the previous six days readings. Day Seven can also be used to catch up if needed.



For days when you are short on time or for people who aren't ready to tackle the entire reading, start by reading the passage(s) in italics under the *Highlights* column. You can always read more, but **these verses will give you the highlights of the Story of Scripture** for that day.
