We planted Elmwood Park Church over 100 years ago, which became Park Street Church in 1926. In 2020, Village Church of Blythewood launched a downtown campus at this location. On Easter Sunday of this year, this became an independent congregation. Matthew Phillips is serving as pastor, and we are excited to financially and prayerfully support Palmetto Life Church.
